May 24, 2024

Following informational meetings with members of the congregation, the Parsonage Task Force maintained its recommendation to sell the parsonage and present a vote to the congregation at the Congregational Meeting on June 2, 2024.

On May 24, 2024, Mike Schlievert made a motion, Karen Hammel second, via email correspondence, to sell the parsonage with an easement for access and authorize the Parsonage Task Force to spend \$30,000 to prepare the property for the sale. An email vote with council members was taken, The motion passed.

Grace Lutheran Church Congregational Meeting
June 2, 2024

The members of Grace Lutheran Church held a Congregational Meeting following worship on June 2, 2024. President Mary Schlievert opened the meeting, Pastor Jaci offered prayer, and the quorum was confirmed with 52 voting members.

The minutes from the January 28, 2024 Congregational Meeting were read by Karen Hammel. A motion was made by Mark Haar, second Bruce King, to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Upon recommendation from the Church Council, a motion was made by Jean Weng, second Rachel Beeler to renew Pastor Jaci Tiell's contract for three years. There was no discussion from the congregation. A ballot vote was taken and the result was: 51 yes, 1 no. The motion to renew Pastor's contract for three years carried.

Upon recommendation from the Church Council, a motion was made by Bruce King, second Mary Lou Kohlii, to use \$30,000 for property upgrades and sell the parsonage. There was no discussion from the congregation. A ballot vote was taken and the result was: 46 yes, 5 no. The motion to proceed with selling the parsonage carried.

The next Church Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 18, 2024 at 7 PM.

Pastor Jaci concluded the meeting with prayer.

A motion was made by Steve Blausey, second Dave Wietelmann, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
